Introduction to Women's Studies is delivered by Stow College in Glasgow Women's Library premises at 15 Berkeley St. You study in a friendly, women-only space and can also use all of the facilities at the college.

The courses offer the chance to move on to further study in Women's Studies, Social Sciences or Social Care. It could be a route into employment—or just the chance to try something different and meet some new people.

We are running two courses which last for six weeks each.. Don't worry if it's been a while since you were last in education—the courses are designed for women who have few or no formal qualifications, and there is plenty of help with study skills and communications.
